

# New Zealand Cyber Security Challenge Code Of Conduct

## **Application**

This code applies to all participants of the New Zealand Cyber Security Challenge (NZCSC).

### **Purpose**

- 1. The purpose of this code is to give guidance to all participants on the standards of conduct required by the NZCSC.
- 2. NZCSC is committed to providing an environment conducive to learning and competing for all participants based on the ethical values of mutual respect, honesty, trust, responsibility, tolerance and empathy.
- 3. NZCSC does not tolerate bullying, harassment (including sexual harassment) or discrimination.
- 4. NZCSC does not tolerate physically aggressive behaviour, violence (including sexual violence), intimidation, coercion or threatening behaviour.
- 5. Participants are expected to act honestly, conscientiously, reasonably and in good faith at all times

#### having regard to:

- a. their own welfare and wellbeing, and the welfare and wellbeing of other participants, organizers and other members of the NZCSC community
- b. the reputation of NZCSC.

### Standards of conduct

Participants must:

- a. act in a manner consistent with the principles set out in this code.
- b. comply with all applicable laws.
- c. treat all people in the NZCSC community with respect at all times and always behave in a courteous manner.
- d. act with honesty and with integrity in their dealings.
- e. ensure that all information they disclose to the NZCSC is accurate, correct, current and complete.
- f. take reasonable care for their own health and safety, and that of others.

# **Participant Discipline**

6. NZCSC has the right to terminate the participation of the person for not acting in accordance with this Code.
